Fast Facts about SLO County Nonprofits

- 1,106 501c3 organizations (Nov. 2011)
 - 33% had annual revenue <\$25,000
- Total Revenue: \$379 million (Form 990)
 - \$15 million below pre-recession
 - 8% decline in revenue per nonprofit

SLO County in California

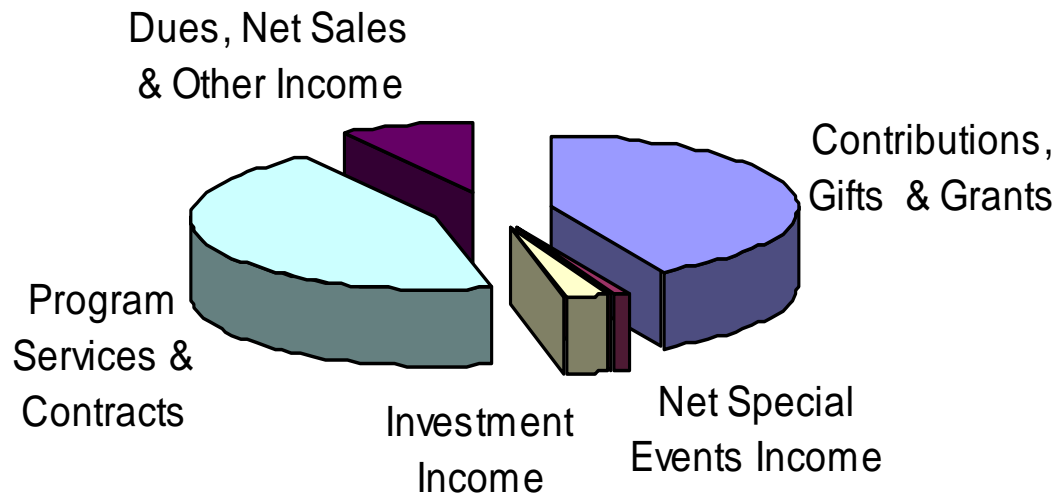
(with ranking among 58 counties)

- Number of Nonprofits: 1,106 (21st)
- Number of Nonprofits per County Resident: .0041 (18th)
- Number of Nonprofits with annual revenue greater than \$25,000: 742 (26th %>\$25,000)
- Number of Nonprofits with annual revenue less than \$25,000: 364 (33rd % <\$25,000)
- Total Revenue to Nonprofits: \$378,683,714 (30th)
- Total Revenue per Nonprofit: \$342,390 (38th)
